


A simple way to record the daily highs and lows that doesn't involve stalking a thermometer is to regularly check *Accuweather.com* or *Wunderground.com*

If using Accuweather:

- 1. Search your location
- 2. Click the "Monthly" tab & scroll for the info you need.

If using Wunderground:

- 1. Set you<mark>r location. We cura</mark>ted our kits based on averages around Brielle.
- 2. To view previous days' temps, click on the name of the weather station just below the title of your town 'If you just click the "History" tab, it often redirects to JFK International Airport as the station. We don't want that!



3. Then, scroll down to the section titled "Weather History" and scroll through "Daily Mode" until you find the days you need info for.



Temperature Quilt Overview

Welcome to the first official Old Spool Block (of the month) Party!

In this document you will find:

- Daily Temperature Journal to record the high and low temps each day. To the right of each day there is a small box that you can use to check off if you've made the flying geese block for that day.
- A Swatch Chart defining each color and the temperature range, as well as tips on how to find historical data for the temperature (so you don't have to stalk the weather report each day)
- Foundation Paper Piece Templates should you choose to use this method to make your flying geese.







Timeline and Participation Guidelines:

- July 1st kick off and begin recording temperatures!

- 5th of each month: prize winner from previous month announced!

Temperature Quilt Cut Chart

1 at a time

High Temperature (center):

31/2" x 61/2" - 1 piece

Low Temperature (wings):

3 1/2" squares - 2 pieces

4 at a time

High Temperature (center):

7½" square - 1 piece

Low Temperature (wings):

4 1/8" x 4 1/8" - 4 pieces
